My child will turn 5 by August 31st... What Can I do to Register My Child for Kindergarten?



Registering early for kindergarten ensures your school can hire the best teachers and be ready for your child on the first day of school



Register your child before the end of June.

Who to contact for registration information?

What to bring to register?

- a certified copy of your child's birth certificate
- your child's updated immunization record
- some districts require proof of residency, i.e. current utility bill, property deed or rental lease

Where do I go to register?

To register **before** school is released for the summer, you simply need to bring the required materials to your home elementary school or district office during school hours. Please call your home school to confirm.

Immunizations Not Current?

Your child does not have to be fully immunized to **register** for Kindergarten! **They must** be current before the start of school.
